Offroad Animal Lower Bash Plate Fitting Instructions

IMPORTANT! – READ BEFORE INSTALLATION

- This bash plate is designed to fit to vehicles fitted with Offroad Animal Cobra or Toro Front bars ONLY
 - When installed in accordance with these instructions, the front protection bar does not affect the operation of the vehicles SRS airbags.
- This product must be installed exactly as per these instructions using only hardware supplied.
- Take a few moments to read instructions thoroughly before beginning work.
- In the event of damage to any bar component please contact OFFROAD ANIMAL to arrange repair/replacement of components.
- Do not use this product for any vehicle make or model other than that specified on these instructions.
- Do not remove labels from this product.
- This product and its fixings must not be modified in any way unless stated in these fitting instructions.
- The installation of this product is recommended for trained personnel.
- These instructions are correct at time of publication. OFFROAD ANIMAL cannot be held responsible for the impact of any changes subsequently made by the vehicle manufacturer. If you find something has changed please contact us to let us know!
- During installation it is the duty of the installer to check correct operation/clearances of all components.
- If Instructions are to be printed for reference in the workshop, it is recommended that they are printed in colour, for best legibility.



GENERAL CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Only wash the product with a PH neutral car wash to prevent paint damage and discolouration.

Plastic parts may be maintained with silicone spray.

Do not use acidic or alkaline based cleaning products.

It is important to perform regular checks (pre trip or on an annual basis) on the installed product. Checks include:

- Visual inspection for damage (eg. cracks, chips, dents etc.)
- Electrical wiring is not rubbing anything or worn out
- Bolts are torqued to correct specification (see torque guide below)

For touching up small stone chips, Offroad Animal recommends the following paint products:

- Dupli-Color Trim & Bumper Paint Black (TB101)
- VHT Hood, Bumper & Trim Paint Black (SP27)

BOLT TORQUE SETTINGS

Use the following bolt torques on all general fasteners, unless otherwise specified.

Use the following bolt torques on all structural front bar mount and tow point fasteners, and rear towbar fasteners, unless otherwise specified.

Always use a torque wrench to set correct torque settings. Ensure torque wrench is set to Nm unit of measurement. Otherwise perform conversion to lb-ft.

WORKSHOP SAFETY

It is the responsibility of the installer to always complete works in a safe manner. Make sure the following safety equipment is available and precautions are observed whilst fitting this product.

Hearing Protection	Always wear ear protection when using power tools.
Eye Protection	Ensure eye protection is always worn when cutting or drilling.
Manual Handling	Do not attempt to lift bar assemblies or rock sliders on your own. Always use two people to lift or use mechanical Lifting aid such as hydraulic lifting trolley.
Vehicle Support	Always ensure vehicle is properly supported when working on it. Do not attempt to fit products whilst suspension work is being carried out. Do not work under a vehicle supported only by a jack.




- 1. This product is designed to fit vehicles fitted with the Offroad Animal Cobra or Toro front bars. The plate can be fitted either during the front bar installation, or separately after the bar is installed.
- 2. The factory lower bash plate needs to be removed. Warrior style is shown in image, but Ti is similar. Remove factory lower bash plate by removing the M8 (13mm head) and M12 (18mm Head Warrior only) Flange head bolts.
- 3. Retain the factory flange head bolts for refitment.

- 4. If fitting to vehicle with existing Cobra or Toro front bar, the center bash plate needs to be removed from the bar / vehicle.
- 5. Loosen but don't remove the two lower M12 fine pitch bolts. Remove the 6x M8 Button head bolts. Once top bolts are out slide the bash plate forward to remove from the vehicle.
- 6. If fitting during a bar installation, complete the following steps in lieu of the center bash plate install steps.

5mm Hex Key 18mm Spanner / Socket

- 7. Fit the 2x Lower Bash Plate support brackets to the M8 threaded points in the front chassis cross member.
- 8. Leave bolts finger tight, such that it is possible to slide the brackets side to side on their slots.

9. Fit the center bash plate to the bar, slide the lower end over the lower M12 bolts, ensure the washer is below the bash plate. Fit 6x M8 Button head bolts finger tight only.

Ensure the bash plate being fitted is the correct revision, with two slots present on the lower edge. Updated center bash plate will be supplied with retrofit kits.

10. Leave bolts loose at this stage.

- 11. Align the lower bash plate support brackets with the slots in the center bash plate.
- 12. Once aligned, tighten the M8 bolts securing the lower bash plate support brackets to the chassis using a 13mm Spanner.

- 13. Fit the lower bash plate to the vehicle. Slide the front over the Loosened M12 Fine pitch bolts, Ensuing the flat washers sit below the bash plate.
- 14. Secure the back of the bash plate to the M8 threaded points in the Chassis using the Factory M8 Flange head bolts.


15. Secure the lower bash plate to the bash plate support brackets using M10x20 Hex bolts and M10 HD flat washers supplied with lower bash plate kit.

- 16. Tighten all bolts, in the following order
 - a. M12 Fine pitch bolts
 - b. Factory M8 Flange Bolts
 - c. M10x20 bolts and
 - d. M8 Button head bolts

- 17. If fitting to vehicle with existing bar install, you are now done!
- 18. If fitting during bar installation, continue installation following front bar fitting instructions after the center bash plate install steps.
- 19. Head Bush and Enjoy your newly protected Patrol!
