- Do not remove labels from this product.
- This product and its fixings must not be modified in any way unless stated in these fitting instructions.
- The installation of this product is recommended for trained personnel.

- During installation it is the duty of the installer to check correct operation/clearances of all components.
- If Instructions are to be printed for reference in the workshop, it is recommended that they are printed in colour, for best legibility.

GENERAL CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Only wash the product with a PH neutral car wash to prevent paint damage and discolouration.

Plastic parts may be maintained with silicone spray.

Do not use acidic or alkaline based cleaning products.

It is important to perform regular checks (pre trip or on an annual basis) on the installed product. Checks include:

- Visual inspection for damage (eg. cracks, chips, dents etc.)
- Electrical wiring is not rubbing anything or worn out
- Bolts are torqued to correct specification (see torque guide below)

For touching up small stone chips, Offroad Animal recommends the following paint products:

- Dupli-Color Trim & Bumper Paint Black (TB101)
- VHT Hood, Bumper & Trim Paint Black (SP27)

Use the following bolt torques on all fasteners, unless otherwise specified.

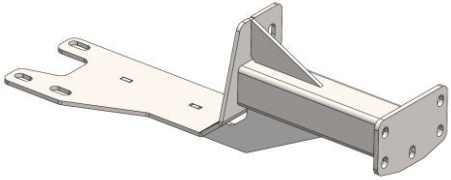
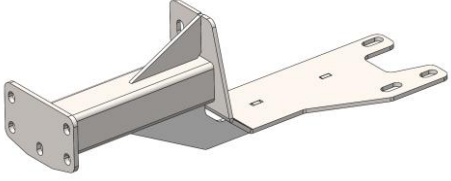
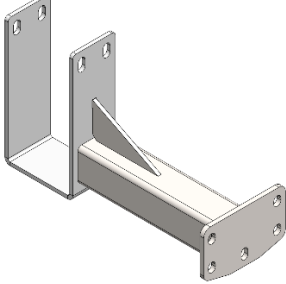
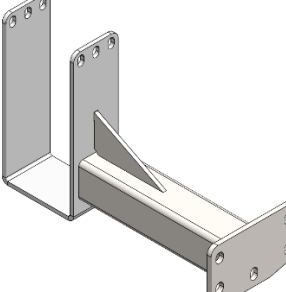
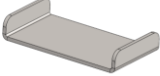
Always use a torque wrench to set correct torque settings. Ensure torque wrench is set to Nm unit of measurement. Otherwise perform conversion to lb-ft.

WORKSHOP SAFETY

It is the responsibility of the installer to always complete works in a safe manner. Make sure the following safety equipment is available and precautions are observed whilst fitting this product.

Hearing Protection 	Always wear ear protection when using power tools.
Eye Protection 	Ensure eye protection is always worn when cutting or drilling.
Manual Handling 	Do not attempt to lift bar assemblies or rock sliders on your own. Always use two people to lift or use mechanical Lifting aid such as hydraulic lifting trolley.
Vehicle Support 	Always ensure vehicle is properly supported when working on it. Do not attempt to fit products whilst suspension work is being carried out. Do not work under a vehicle supported only by a jack.

**NOTE:**

MY25 facelift X-Terrain models have extra plastic trim on the sills (not pictured) that need to be unclipped/removed for fitment of sliders.

1. Remove factory side steps if fitted by removing the 6x bolts (2 per mount) securing them to the body using a 12mm socket.
2. Discard factory steps and bolts.

3. Installation of the front bracket is as shown (viewing up from underneath the vehicle). Locate the area around the front cross member on the LHS of the vehicle.
4. Remove the M6 bolt that is already on the vehicle shown with the arrow.
5. Put the LH front mount up to the chassis as shown and reinstall the factory M6 bolt. Leave loose.
6. Using a nut plate, install an M10x30 bolt on the top side of the photo, again leaving it loose.
7. Next fit M10x30 bolt on bottom side of photo with flange nut. You may need to undo the M6 from step 4 holding the plastic guard to get the nut into place. Leave loose.

8. Insert a nut plate through the chassis window shown with the arrow.
9. Put a small bend in the stick with your hand and then line up the nut plate with the corresponding point on the front mount and feed in an M10x30 bolt and washer.
10. Once the bolt has been started, use a floor jack to hold the front of the mount up as high as it will go while using a flat blade screwdriver to lever the mount as far away from the centre of the vehicle as possible. Then torque up the M10 bolt.
11. Remember this bracket needs to be as high as possible in its slot.
12. Torque 3 bolts underneath.

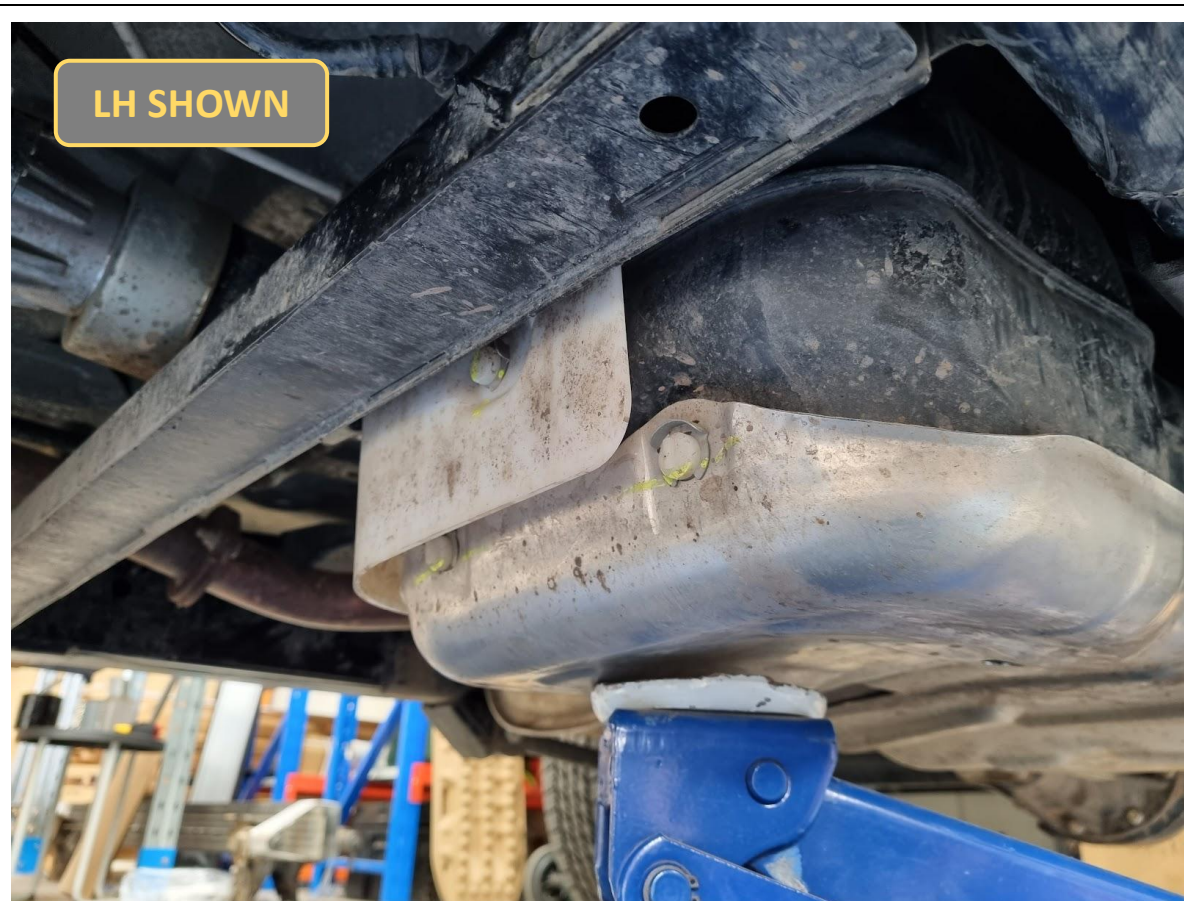

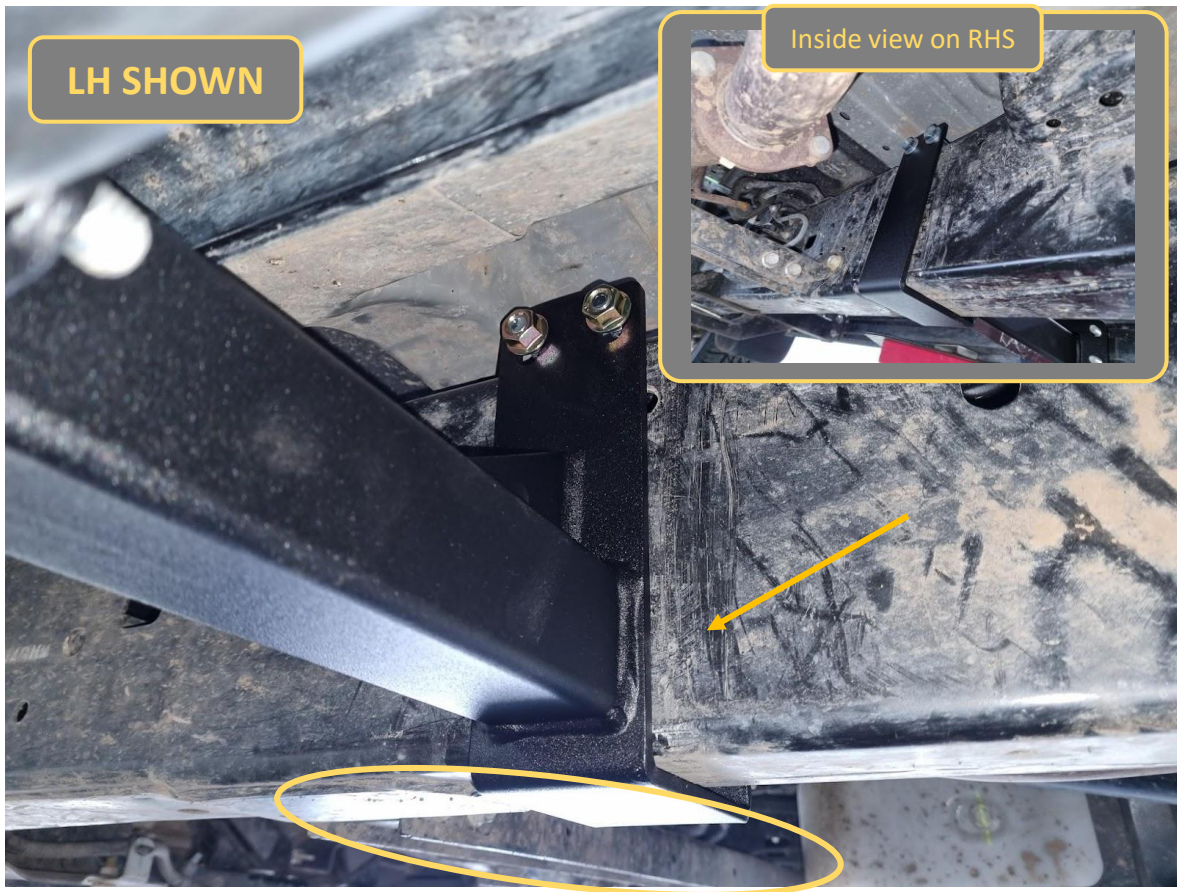
13. To fit the middle and rear mounts on the LHS, the fuel tank needs to be lowered for bolt access.
14. To lower the fuel tank, place a floor jack under the front half of the fuel tank and lightly touch the tank.
15. Remove 2x bolts on holding the front strap of the fuel tank.
16. Gently lower the front end of the tank down about 100mm with the jack. Leave jack in place to support the tank.

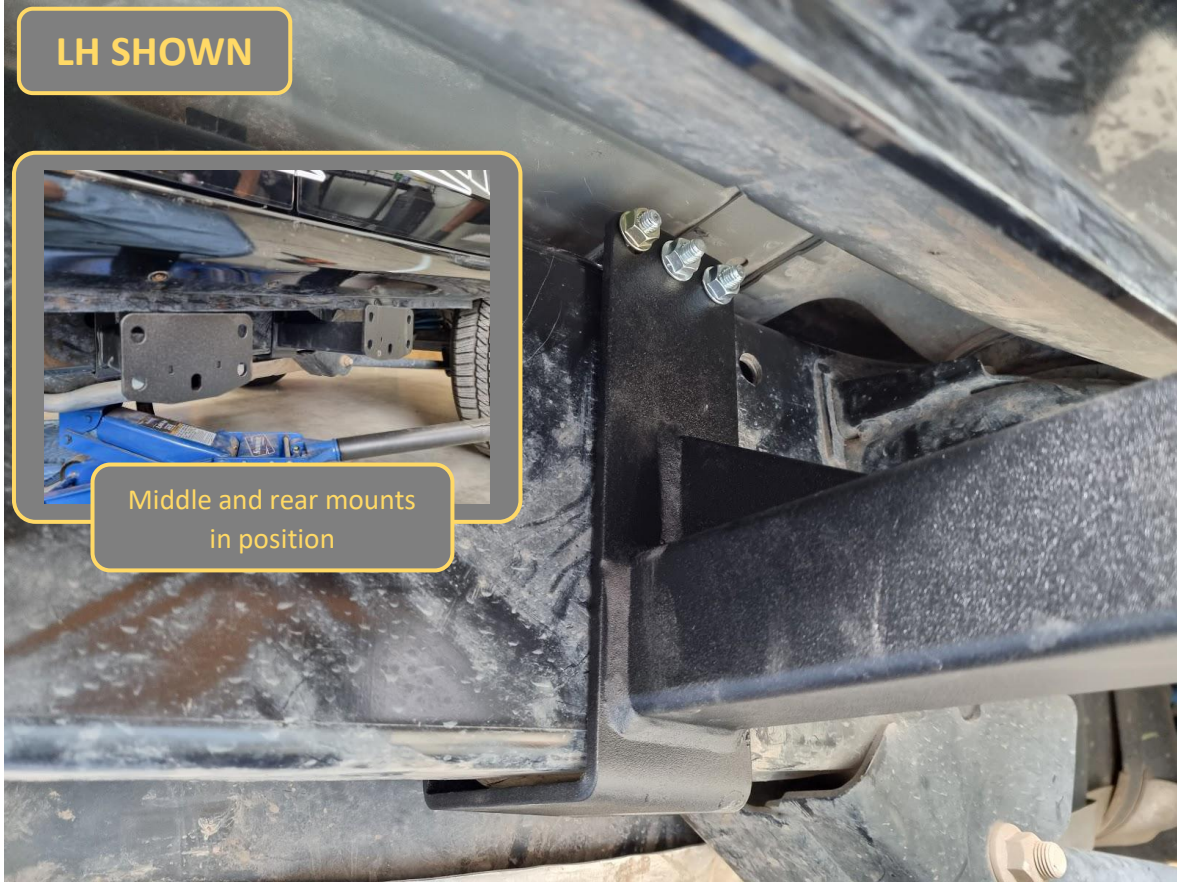

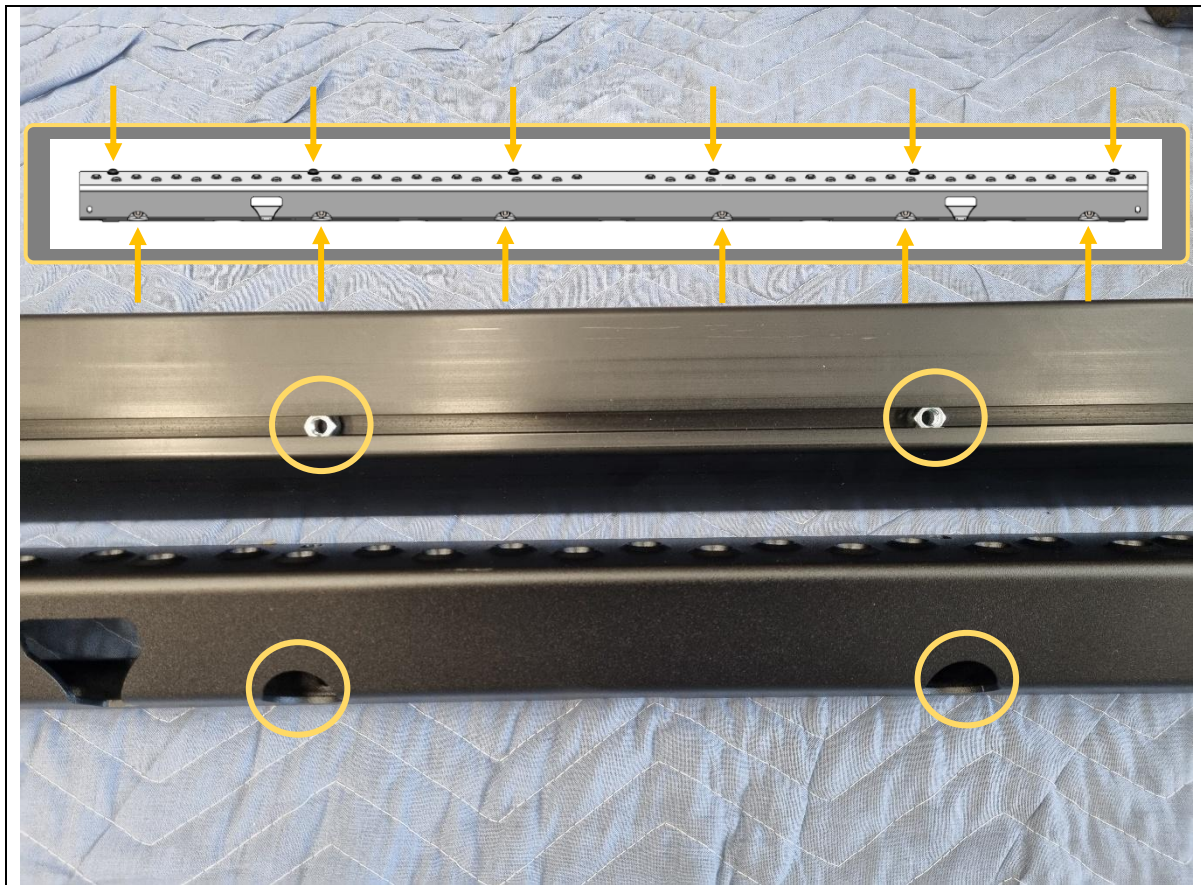

17. Fit the middle mount approximately 75mm rearwards of the middle chassis cross member (circled). 18. If the fit is very loose on the chassis rail, insert the supplied shim(s) between the mount and chassis at the location shown with the arrow. 19. Using a long socket extension bar, feed 2x M10x120 bolts and washers over the top of the fuel tank and chassis rail from the centre of the car, and through the slots on the top of the mount. Secure with flange nuts. Ensure bolts sit in between the chassis rail and any brake lines. 20. Push the mount as high up as possible and torque the bolts. 21. Fit the rear mount approximately 75mm forwards of the rear cabin mount. 22. If the fit is very loose on the chassis rail, insert the supplied shim(s) as explained in step 18. 23. Using a long socket extension bar, feed 3x M8x120 bolts and washers over the top of the fuel tank and chassis rail from the centre of the car, and through the slots on the top of the mount. Secure with flange nuts. Ensure bolts sit in between the chassis rail and any brake lines. 24. Push the mount as high up as possible and torque the bolts. 25. Raise the fuel tank and resecure the fuel tank strap with the 2x factory bolts.	TOOLS REQUIRED 13mm socket/ spanner 14mm socket Socket extension bar Hydraulic floor jack

26. Find an open space and place the step in line with the slider extrusion.
27. Feed M8 nuts through the top and outside slots in the extrusion and carefully line them up with the corresponding mounting holes in the step. There are 6x nuts for the top slot and 6x nuts for the outside slot.

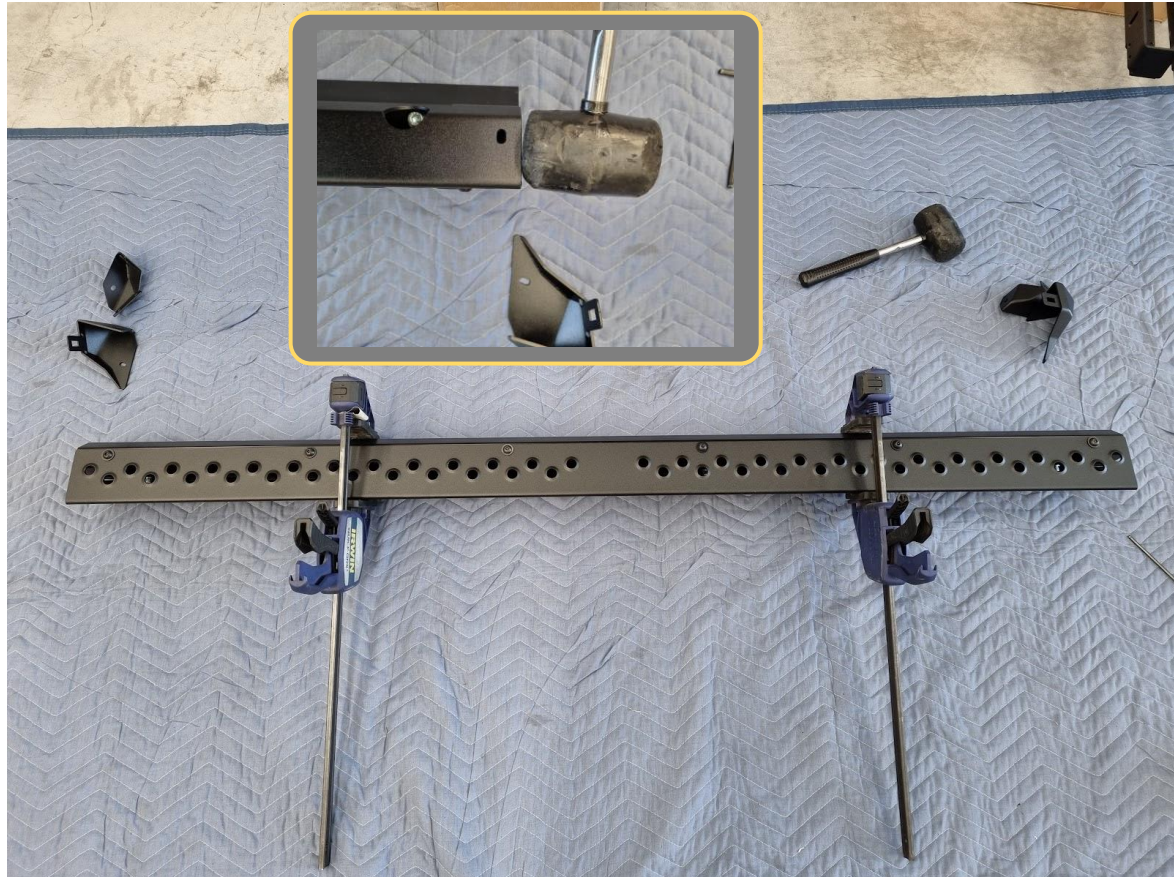

28. Fit the step onto the slider extrusion.
29. Use M8x20 black button head screws, black M8 washers and M8 Nuts on 6x locations on the top row of the step.
30. Use M8x20 cap head screws, M8 washers and M8 nuts on 6x locations on the bottom side of the step.

31. Adjust the position of the step on the slider extrusion so it is central.
32. Clamp the step to the extrusion with a set of soft clamps to ensure they are pressed firmly up against each other.
33. Once happy with the alignment, tighten all bolts on slider extrusion, using a 5mm and 6mm hex key.

34. Insert 1x M6 cage nut in the rectangular slot of the outer section of the stub nose endcap with a flat blade screwdriver.
35. Assemble the corresponding endcap rear cover to the outer section and secure with 2x M6x20 black button head screws, black washers and flange nuts. Leave finger tight at this stage.

36. Slide 2x M10 Hex nuts into the T slots on the back side of the extrusion. (1 per slot)
37. Fit the end cap to the end of the extrusion.
38. Secure with M10x15 button head screws and washers on T slot nuts and M6x20 black button head and washer on the outside, through the step plate. Tighten bolts once aligned properly.

39. Slide 12x M10x25 Hex bolts into the T slots on the back side of the extrusion. 4 bolts per slot.
40. Loosely arrange the bolts in 3x groups of 4, in approximate location of mounts on the vehicle.
41. Fit the mirrored end cap to the remaining end of the slider, as per install steps 34-38.

42. With the help of a friend or mate, lift step and extrusion up to brackets. Align all the bolts so they fit through the corresponding holes in the brackets.
43. Once all the bolts are through into the brackets, loosely secure M10 flange nuts on the M10 bolts to hold step up. Leave the slider step free to move fore/aft at this stage.

44. Adjust the fore / aft position of sliders on mounts to achieve even appearance if required.

45. Torque all M10 flange nuts.

46. Don't be stiff, put the supplied logo plates on the step as shown. It looks much better with it on.
47. Repeat the entire install for RHS (easier side) and you're all done.
